

Register your smartphone at the event

To place bids on auction items or to make a donation, register with a GiveSmart sta member. GiveSmart staff members will be present at the event to be your "personal shopper" if you do not prefer to bid via your own device.

Charge your devices because bidding will be done on your smartphone or tablet!


Bid via smartphone

Click the blue link in your welcome text message and it will take you to your personal bidding page. Click on an item you would like to bid on. The GiveSmart smart system pre-populates with the next minimum bid so all you have to do is press BID. If you'd like to go higher just enter a new amount and press BID. To have the GiveSmart smart system automatically bid for you to a designed amount, please select the AUTO tab and enter a higher amount. The system will bid for you incrementally up until your designated amount only if some-one bids against you.

Bid via text

To see current bid, reply to your welcome text and simply text the 3 digit item number. Example: "102" then press send. Then, text the 3 digit item number and amount you would like to bid. No dollar signs (\$) needed. Example: "102 300" then press send. You placed a \$300 bid on item number 102.

Prior to joining Denver Law, Freeman worked as an attorney at Advancement Project, a national civil rights group, where she assisted grassroots organizations across the country on social justice advocacy campaigns around education and juvenile justice policy, housing, and voting rights issues. Michelle has a lifelong passion for mentoring and developing young people in her personal and professional life and has partnered with organizations such as Big Sisters, NAMIC, NABJ and The Posse Foundation. She is also a member of the Advisory Board for Howard University's School of Communications and a member of the Advisory Board for Reel Works, a New York based non-profit that helps teenagers create films about their lives.

In 2017, with the sudden violent death of her seven year old daughter, Gabrielle, Michelle began a journey to create a meaningful legacy in honor of Gabrielle. In partnership with The Hord Foundation, Inc., Michelle created, "Gabrielle's Wings."
